This year's joint Constitution Day Lecture and Cooper Lecture convenes a panel of two esteemed jurists – **Judge Stephanos Bibas** and **Judge Arianna Freeman '01** – to discuss challenging questions of jurisprudence. As members of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, they regularly hear cases that shape federal law.

The event will include brief remarks, a panel discussion moderated by **Professor Krista Thomason**, and a Q&A. A light reception will follow.

Directions to Swarthmore College's Lang Performing Arts Center (LPAC) Cinema

(Not to be confused with the Lang Center for Civic and Social Responsibility, a separate building on campus)

Parking

Stay in the right lane on Baltimore Pike, and in less than 1/4 mile, turn right onto PA Route 320 South. At the next traffic light, turn right to stay on Route 320/Chester Road. At the next traffic light, turn right onto College Avenue. From College Avenue, turn right onto Cedar Lane at the stone "Swarthmore College" sign. At the next stop sign, turn left onto Elm Avenue. Go one block and turn left at the North Entrance to the campus, Whittier Place.

The DuPont parking lot will be on your right, past some small houses. Across the Whittier circle at the corner of the parking lot is a map of the campus, in front of the Science Center. Walk past the Science Center and Martin Biological Laboratory to reach the Lang Music Building down steps to your right, and then the LPAC on your right.

Rideshare

When using rideshare services, the best drop-off location is the official address of Swarthmore College: 500 College Avenue, Swarthmore, PA 19081.
